Subject Pages

Course Pages

These are pages that point to resources for a specific course or assignment.

For example:

- PSYC 250: Academic and Career Pathways in Psychology
- HSA 369: Program Evaluation
- RELS 305: Jewish Christian Encounter

To access the Library Guides **subject pages**, go to: <http://libguides.metrostate.edu/> or select the "Search by Subject" icon from the library homepage. Select a subject from the list. You will then see a page of resources (databases, websites, etc.) useful for research on your topic.

To access the Library Guides **course pages**, go to: <http://libguides.metrostate.edu/> or select the "Search by Subject" icon from the library homepage. Click on the "Course Pages" tab; then select your course from the list. **Please note:** not all instructors have requested course pages, so your course might not be on the list.

Library Guides also include some "How To" guides to assist with other aspects of doing research.
